Goals of this assignment:

1. To practice recording on camera
2. To practice framing for a variety of different purposes
3. To practice asking open-ended questions
4. To practice capturing clear and strong audio
5. To practice editing a clip to identify the strongest soundbites

Steps:

1. In your small group, you will determine a general question that you think could encourage interesting and engaging open-ended questions.
2. Determine a location to set up your camera.
3. Record at least 5 people responding to the same question. Listen carefully to so you can identify the key soundbites you can use in the final video.
4. Record some additional b-roll to show location and set context.
5. Preview at least 2 "how-to" tutorials on either iMovie or Adobe Premiere"
6. Upload your video clips into the program of your choice.
7. Follow the steps in the tutorial to edit each clip to include just the portion of the answer you want.
8. Add clips of b-roll in places for introduction, emphasis or transitions, and conclusion.
9. Organize the clips in a logical way that makes sense for viewers. Add any finishing touches like text or music (ensure it's royalty-free).
10. Render and export your video and email to your teacher.
